

Whitchurch Canal Basin

Planning approval has been granted to extend the canal under Chemistry Bridge onto land East of Meadowcroft and to the North of the road at Chemistry to provide a canal basin with mooring for up to 8 narrowboats, a picnic area, and accessible footpaths across the site.

We believe this will be a very attractive area for Whitchurch residents and will encourage visitors to the town with benefits for

local businesses.

The current best estimate of total cost is about £560,000 and the Trust is working on reducing costs.

The project may now be completed in phases and an application has been submitted for the funding of stage one (with a decision expected in September). Stage One would be some land levelling and path improvements.
